

Mildewproof Neutral Silicone Sealant

Description

It is a single component, 100% neutral silicone sealant with excellent anti-fungal properties. It resists mildew and suitable for many common areas where under high humidity and temperature conditions may be encountered. It will bond to form a durable, flexible, waterproof seal on most building materials.

Packing

300ml cartridge or 600ml sausage; 20kg/pail, 220kg/drum, or customized.

Storage

Sealed and stored in cool and dry place. It is suggested to be stored at $5\sim25^{\circ}$ C, and the humidity is less than 50%RH. If the temperature is higher than 40 $^{\circ}$ C or the humidity is more than 80%RH, the shelf life may be shorter.

Shelf life: 12 months
